POSEY COUNTY COMMISSIONERS TUESDAY JULY 2ND, 2019

The Posey County Commissioners met in regular session at the Hovey House on Tuesday, July 2nd, 2019 at 9:00 a.m. The following members were present at said meeting: Commissioner Carl Schmitz, Commissioner Jay Price, and Commissioner Randy Thornburg; Auditor Sarah Beth Meighen and Commissioner Attorney Joseph Harrison.

C. Schmitz called the Posey County Commissioners Meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance.

MINUTES

R. Thornburg made a motion to approve the minutes from the June 18th, 2019 Commissioners meeting; J. Price seconded. The motion carried with a vote of 3-0.

CLAIMS

R. Thornburg made a motion to approve the Claims as presented; J. Price seconded. The motion carried with a vote of 3-0.

CLERK'S REPORT

J. Price made a motion to approve the May Clerk's report; R. Thornburg seconded. The motion carried with a vote of 3-0.

WINFIELD SUBDIVISION VACATION

C. Schmitz stated at the June 18th, 2019 Commissioners meeting, the Commissioners vacated the public road ways in the recently vacated Winfield Subdivision. Mr. Schmitz stated for public record, those road names are Walnut and First Street. R. Thornburg made a motion to vacate Walnut and First Streets as public roadways; J. Price seconded. The motion carried with a vote of 3-0.

SRI TAX SALE CONTRACT CHANGES

Posey County Treasurer, Vicki Peerman, informed the Commissioners she has an amendment to the tax sale contract that needs to be signed. Mrs. Peerman is also informing the Commissioners that SRI, the company that handles the tax sale, has increased their fees from \$75.00 to \$100.00 per parcel. Mr. Harrison stated those fees as paid for by the buyer. Mrs. Peerman explained that the total fee of \$125.00 that is added to each property is \$100.00 to SRI and \$25.00 to the County.

J. Price made a motion to approve the amendment to the tax sale; R. Thornburg seconded. The motion carried with a vote of 3-0.

BOOKING FEE ORDINANCE

Posey County Sheriff, Tom Latham, addressed the Commissioners regarding a proposed ordinance that would allow the Sheriff's department to create a \$50.00 booking fee. Mr. Latham explained this would be applied only to those who have been convicted and will be used to offset the cost of operating the jail. Mr. Harrison stated this will be the fist reading of ordinance number 2019-07-02-01 and the second reading will be at the July 16th, 2019 Commissioners meeting. J. Price made a motion to approve this ordinance; R. Thornburg seconded. The motion carried with a vote of 3-0.

No further business was discussed and the meeting was adjourned.
